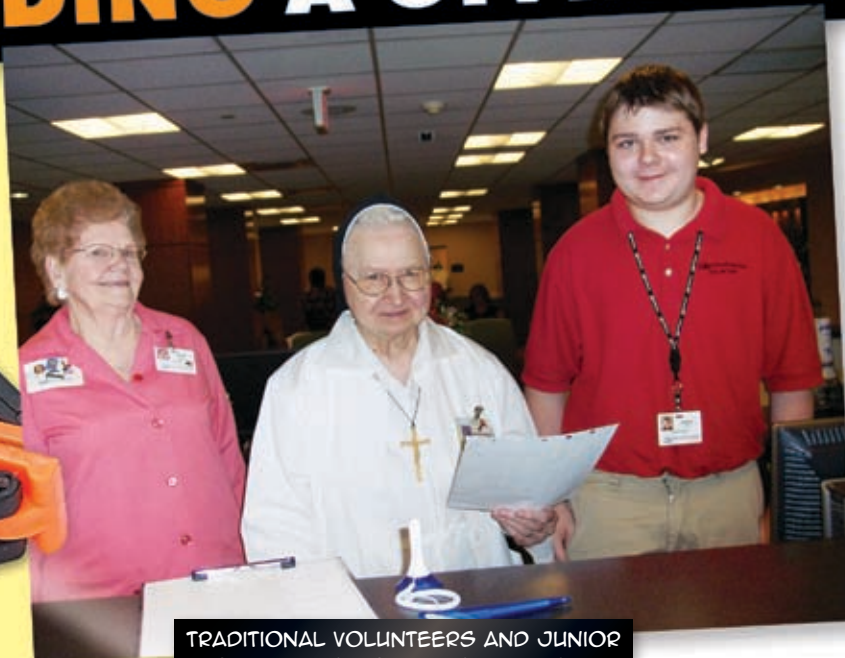


BUILDING A GIVING SPIRIT
